- **2**. **Terms of reference:** To review the performance of the Insurance Ombudsman and other matters related to enhance efficiency of Institution of Insurance Ombudsmen.
- 3. Tenure: The tenure of the Committee will be two years.
- 4. **Meetings:** The Advisory Committee will generally meet at least twice a year and will submit a report to IRDAI on an annual basis for review and further action as deemed necessary.
- 5. Quorum: Three Members would constitute a quorum
- **6**. **Fees and Other Expenses:** The Chairman and Members shall be eligible for travel, boarding and lodging in addition to sitting fee at par with other committees constituted by the Authority.
